Brief

Bramble Court, Carlisle, an Impact Housing 'Living Well' scheme for over 55s, features 40 new build one and two bedroom houses. Living Well schemes combine accommodation for those wishing to retain complete independence, through to those needing more support to live at home. With background support and a 24-hour care service, Impact Housing required a 'wow factor' interior to match those facilities. Buckingham Interiors managed the entire project from consultation and design, to delivery and installation.
